How Does the Holy Spirit Work?'

The Holy Spirit works through the Mighty Three in One:

John 5:26 - 26 For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;

This Scripture tells us that the Father is the ultimate source of life. He has life in Himself that He has given to the Son. The Father is the source, the Son is the channel of that source, and the Holy Spirit is the power that flows through that channel. The Mighty Three in One in action. Glory!

Before God speaks, the Spirit always moves. The Spirit releases the source and touches our life. It is Jesus, the Son who poured out the Holy Spirit from the Father.

Acts 1:8a - 8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you...

Acts 2:33 - 33 Therefore being by the right

hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

There are different emblems of the Holy Spirit throughout the Bible that represent the Holy Spirit to us.

The Dove:

John 1:32-33 - 32 And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. 33 And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizes with the Holy Ghost.

Oil/Anointing:

Luke 4:18 - 18 The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Acts 10:38 - 38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Hebrews 1:9 - 9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, [even] thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

Water:

John 7:37-39 - 37 In the last day, that great [day] of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. 38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. 39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet [given]; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

Isaiah 44:3 - 3 For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring:

A Seal:

Ephesians 1:13 - 13 In whom ye also [trusted], after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

Ephesians 4:30 - 30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

2 Corinthians 1:22 - 22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.

Wind:

John 3:8 - 8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

Acts 2:1-2 - 1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

Fire:

Exodus 3:2 - 2 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush [was] not consumed.

Leviticus 9:23b-24 – 23b ...and the glory of the LORD appeared unto all the people. 24 And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed upon the altar the burnt offering and the fat: [which] when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces.

We receive the Holy Spirit in us when we first believe that Jesus is Lord.² We receive it by faith and not by works, nor by our own obedience to the Law³. We receive it by repentance, being born again, by obeying God, and through the baptism of the Holy Ghost.⁴

The Holy Spirit is the sustaining power of the believer, proving that Christ abides within a person, proving that one is truly saved and is indeed, the

Temple of The Holy Spirit.⁵

The infilling of the Holy Spirit follows our obedience to God and His discipline for our lives, including walking in the commands and teachings of Jesus with a blameless heart.⁶ The Holy Spirit also indwells the church in a special way, for we are the church, the Temple of God. And if anyone defiles this temple God will destroy him, for we are holy.⁷

There are many different Church denominations and many published Bibles that attest to their beliefs. However, they all say the Holy Spirit is with you, and with all of us to prepare us for salvation. God is omnipresent by His Spirit and gives mankind a conscience of truth vs error and right vs wrong.⁸ But the Holy Spirit does not yet dwell in you until you believe that Jesus is Lord.

The Holy Spirit comes to dwell in you when you believe. And as you continue to grow in faith, you are led to a Pentecostal moment when the Holy Spirit through a mighty rushing wind enters you causing you to be baptized in the Holy Ghost and Fire. Glory! As we continue to grow in the wonders of the Spirit,

our faith grows, by leaps and bounds from 20%, to 60%, to 100%. Going deeper and deeper out into the deep. Going from your ankles to your knees to your shoulders in the river of God, until you are swimming in His Glory!

The Glorious Holy Spirit is with us, in us and upon us for service in God's Kingdom. This service is directed by the Holy Spirit and the action begins through you. As you step out in faith, your obedience flips the switch to the Spirit. Because of your obedience and proper use of the anointing, your hunger for more of God will continue to grow and grow and grow. We go deeper as we long to draw closer to the Lord. We are in Him and He in us. We are the Temple of God.

Section One:

The Holy Spirit With You

The Holy Spirit With You

The Holy Spirit is all-powerful (omnipotent.) He is also ever-present, He is everywhere, (omnipresent.) However, prior to the cross at Calvary, the Holy Spirit was limited and could not dwell within a person. But when Jesus ascended to the right hand of the Father as our intercessor, and when the Day of Pentecost had fully come, The Holy Spirit stepped into His role to fulfill the mission God had called Him to do on earth.

The Holy Spirit is with us to open our hearts to accept Christ. He is with us as a wee small inner voice, preparing the way for us to the Lord. He is with us when we accept and receive the new birth, He is with us as we invite the Lord into our hearts, and at that moment our sins are totally forgiven, covered by the blood of Jesus Christ. When the Father sees us, He sees the blood of Jesus rather than our sins.

Romans 3:11 - 11 There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God.

This says that there is no one who seeks God. This
